Thank you for your interest in this program. I will review all requests and send more information to you. All students must be at least 21. If you have children that you want to share the information with you will receive a lot of information in the class you can teach them. I will be more than happy to talk with them if you wish. Unfortunately we do not have a program for people under 21. If selected, about two weeks before each class you will need to come to the Covington Police Department at 1143 Oak Street and sign a form that lets me check your criminal history. We cannot by law let a convicted felon possess a firearm. Also we have a waiver form to sign, as shooting guns is inherently dangerous. Safety is paramount in our classes. This class is geared to 38 revolvers (ammo included) because that is a simple weapon to teach basic safety and gun tactics, and in my opinion the most reliable weapon for self defense. If you have personal weapons please feel free to bring them and I will be glad to check them out and talk with you about that peculiar gun's functions. The classes start at 8:00 am till about 11:30 then one hour for lunch (not included) then 12:30 to about 4:30 pm. We will be on the ground and around gun oils so wear clothing that is ok to get dirty. Eye and ear protection is a must and will be provided. The "TKO" of gun safety:

"T" - Treat every weapon as if it is loaded

"K" - Keep your finger off the trigger until you are ready to fire

"O" - Observe muzzle direction
